



Law Office of Jeffrey Jackson Opens Nashville Criminal Defense Practice

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The Law Office of Jeffrey Jackson has announced the establishment of its Nashville criminal defense practice, serving defendants across Davidson County and ten surrounding Tennessee counties. The practice is anchored by founding attorney Jeffrey Jackson, who spent more than seven years as an Assistant District Attorney in the Nashville District Attorney's Office before transitioning to criminal defense. That prosecutorial background gives the practice direct insight into how the state investigates, builds, and argues criminal cases in Davidson County.

During his tenure as a Nashville ADA, Jackson participated in prosecuting drug violations, domestic violence cases, DUIs, aggravated robberies, and homicides through the Davidson County criminal court system. He now applies that experience from the defense side, working to identify weaknesses in the prosecution's evidence before charges are formally filed and throughout the life of a case, with a focus on protecting the constitutional rights of the accused.

Among the areas the practice evaluates during initial case review is judicial diversion. Under Tennessee's judicial diversion statute, first-time offenders facing certain charges may have their cases dismissed upon successful completion of a probationary period, resulting in no criminal conviction on the defendant's record. Prosecutorial experience gives Jackson knowledge of which Davidson County cases the district attorney's office will agree to resolve through diversion and which it will not, allowing him to set accurate expectations from the first hearing.

The practice works within the local court structure. Davidson County's criminal court system operates through three Criminal Court divisions handling felony matters and four General Sessions Court judges handling misdemeanor preliminary hearings. Familiarity with that structure and with individual judges' tendencies in evidentiary rulings, bail hearings, and plea negotiations is the kind of local knowledge built through sustained Davidson County practice, which Jackson accumulated over seven years of daily courtroom work as a Nashville ADA.

Jeffrey Jackson is a member of the Tennessee Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, the Nashville Bar Association, and the Tennessee Bar Association. Those memberships reflect ongoing engagement with the criminal defense community and access to continuing legal education on Tennessee's evolving criminal statutes and procedural rules. Timing remains a consideration for defendants. Under T.C.A. Section 40-2-102, Tennessee sets a general one-year limitation period for the prosecution of most misdemeanor offenses, with longer periods applying to felonies. The period between arrest and the first court appearance is often the most consequential window for building a defense, as it allows counsel time to preserve evidence, interview witnesses, and evaluate procedural issues. The firm's consultation, available around the clock, reflects that emphasis on early case review.

"Having spent more than seven years building and arguing criminal cases for the Nashville DA's office, I learned how prosecutors evaluate evidence, decide which cases to take to trial, and which weaknesses in their own case they hope defense attorneys will miss," said Jeffrey Jackson, Founding Attorney at The Law Office of Jeffrey Jackson. "That knowledge is practical and case-specific: knowing which Davidson County prosecutors will agree to judicial diversion on a first-time drug charge, which judges are more receptive to suppression motions based on unlawful stops, and how the DA's office assesses the strength of its witness testimony before offering a plea. A Nashville criminal defendant is entitled to an attorney who has seen the case from the other side, and the consultation is where that process starts."
