



NC Car Accident Lawyers Addresses Complex Insurance Coverage Issues for Durham Rideshare Accident Cases

The firm notes that rideshare accident cases present unique challenges compared to traditional vehicle accidents. Victims often face confusion about which insurance policy applies, whether the driver was logged into the app at the time of the crash, and how to preserve critical trip-related evidence before it becomes difficult to access. These complexities can significantly impact the compensation available to injured parties.

Durham's universities, hospitals, downtown nightlife, Research Triangle Park access, and major commuter routes create frequent rideshare demand throughout the city. With heavy traffic along major corridors including NC-147, I-85, and US-15-501, combined with high demand for rideshare services around Duke University, North Carolina Central University, and major medical facilities, the potential for rideshare accidents has grown substantially. The firm's focus on these cases reflects the evolving transportation

landscape in Durham and the surrounding Research Triangle Park area.

Rideshare accident cases involve multiple layers of insurance coverage that change based on the driver's app status. Under North Carolina's Transportation Network Company statute, when a TNC driver is logged into the app but not providing service, required coverage includes at least \$50,000 per person, \$100,000 per accident for bodily injury, and \$25,000 for property damage. When the driver is engaged in TNC service, required liability coverage is at least \$1 million.

Under North Carolina law, app status can be a key issue because a transportation network company driver may be treated differently depending on whether the driver was offline, logged into the app and waiting for a request, or actively providing TNC service. That is why trip receipts, app screenshots, GPS data, driver information, and timing records can be important in determining which insurance policies may apply.

"Rideshare accident cases in Durham can become complicated very quickly because the available insurance coverage may depend on what the Uber or Lyft driver was doing in the app at the exact time of the crash," stated a firm representative. "Our goal is to help injured people understand their options, protect important evidence, and avoid mistakes that could affect their claim under North Carolina law."

Evidence that may matter after a Durham rideshare accident includes: Uber or Lyft trip receipt, app screenshots, driver name and vehicle information, pickup and drop-off details, GPS route details, crash report, medical records, witness information, photos or video, and insurance communications. This information may help injured rideshare passengers, drivers hit by an Uber or Lyft vehicle, pedestrians, cyclists, delivery drivers, and families of people hurt in app-based transportation crashes. North Carolina's contributory negligence law adds another layer of complexity to these cases. Under this legal doctrine, accident victims must be careful to avoid recorded statements, assumptions about fault, or quick settlement decisions that could jeopardize their ability to recover compensation.
