

All Pro Thornton Deck Builders Expands Regional Service Area to Louisville

THORNTON, CO - August 19, 2026 -

All Pro Thornton Deck Builders has extended its deck design, construction, and restoration work to Louisville, Colorado, adding the Boulder County city to a service area that already covers Thornton, Denver, and much of the surrounding metropolitan region. The Colorado contractor confirmed the expansion in 2026, pointing to steady demand for durable outdoor living space among homeowners along the northern Front Range.

The extended coverage gives Louisville property owners access to the full range of work the firm performs across the Denver metropolitan area, including custom deck design and installation, deck repair and restoration, pool decks, porches, and pergolas. Projects are built with pressure-treated lumber, composite decking from manufacturers such as Trex and TimberTech, and steel or engineered framing chosen for local conditions. Each installation carries a two-year labor warranty, and clients receive weekly progress updates throughout construction.

Louisville is a community of roughly 20,800 residents in southeastern Boulder County, positioned about eight miles from Boulder and inside a metropolitan area that counts more than 320,000 people. Census estimates place the median household income near \$147,000, and most homes in the area are owner-occupied, conditions generally associated with sustained spending on home-improvement and outdoor construction. The expansion moves a locally owned business into a market where established housing stock frequently calls for both new deck construction and the repair of aging structures.

Company leadership tied the decision to the construction conditions common along the northern Front Range. "The extension gives Louisville homeowners a local option for decks engineered for Colorado's freeze-thaw cycles, heavy snow loads, and high-altitude sun exposure," said David Miller, owner of All Pro Thornton Deck Builders. "Every project in the city receives the same construction standards, warranty terms, and weekly reporting the business applies across the rest of the metropolitan area."

Louisville traces its origins to 1877, when coal mining anchored the local economy, and it shifted toward a residential character after the mines closed in the mid-20th century. The result is a mix of established neighborhoods and newer development, and the city has appeared repeatedly on national rankings of places to live. That combination of older homes and higher-value properties has produced a base of aging decks in need of replacement alongside demand for new outdoor construction.

Material selection carries particular weight in the area's climate, where wide temperature swings and freeze-thaw activity can shorten the lifespan of poorly built structures. Composite decking is used on many projects because it resists warping, rotting, splintering, and splitting and needs limited maintenance once installed, while pressure-treated lumber and steel framing address load and durability requirements. The firm also builds pergolas, integrated lighting, fire pits, and outdoor kitchen features within larger outdoor living projects, and it coordinates permitting and inspections as part of each build.

Deck construction in the city requires permitting and inspection under local building code, and the company handles those steps alongside design and construction. A typical project begins with an on-site consultation to determine layout, materials, and budget, followed by permitting, the build itself, and a final inspection. Structural elements are specified to meet snow-load and wind requirements set for the region, an aspect that carries added weight for elevated decks and second-story structures. Written estimates are prepared before work begins, and a standard residential build generally runs several weeks from approval to completion, depending on size and material.

The company entering the Louisville market has operated across the Denver metropolitan area since 2012 and is licensed, bonded, and insured in Colorado. The addition extends coverage that already includes Westminster, Broomfield, Lafayette, Superior, Arvada, and Denver. All Pro Thornton Deck Builders received a 2026 recognition from BusinessRate and works with regional suppliers to source decking and structural materials for area projects.
