



All Pro Thornton Deck Builders Expands Service Area to Northglenn

THORNTON, CO - September 11, 2026 -

All Pro Thornton Deck Builders has expanded its residential deck construction services into Northglenn, Colorado, extending design, installation, and repair work to homeowners throughout the community. The change broadens a service area that previously centered on Thornton and adjacent portions of the north Denver metropolitan region.

The expansion answers steady demand for outdoor living improvements across the northern suburbs of Denver, where aging wooden decks and growing interest in composite materials have prompted many property owners to seek professional construction and replacement work. Northglenn, which borders Thornton along the Interstate 25 corridor, shares similar housing stock and climate conditions, which allows the company to apply the same construction standards used in its established territory.

Within Northglenn, the company now handles new deck construction, multi-level and elevated designs, railing replacement, structural repair, and the installation of composite, cedar, and pressure-treated lumber surfaces. Each project follows the permitting and inspection requirements set by the City of Northglenn, which reviews residential deck work for compliance with structural, height, and setback standards under the adopted

building code.

"The addition of Northglenn allows the company to serve a broader stretch of the north metro area without reducing the attention given to each project," said David Miller, owner of All Pro Thornton Deck Builders. Miller added that the crews assigned to the new territory are the same teams that complete work in Thornton, a step that keeps building practices and scheduling consistent across both cities.

Material choice figures prominently in the type of work the company performs in the new territory. Composite decking, which resists moisture and requires less ongoing maintenance than natural wood, has gained share among homeowners weighing long-term upkeep against initial cost, while cedar and pressure-treated pine remain common selections for their appearance and lower entry price. The company evaluates each site for grade, drainage, and existing structures before recommending a material and layout.

Colorado's climate places specific demands on deck construction, with wide temperature swings, heavy spring snowfall, and elevated ultraviolet exposure all contributing to material wear over time. Decks in the region commonly require attention within a decade or two, depending on material and exposure, and the company reports that repair and replacement inquiries account for a substantial portion of the requests received from established neighborhoods.

Northglenn, incorporated in the late 1960s, contains a mix of established single-family neighborhoods and newer residential development, and many of its older homes feature decks that have reached the end of a typical service life. That combination of aging structures and continued homebuilding has created ongoing work for contractors focused on outdoor living space across the north metro corridor.

Typical residential deck projects in the area move from an initial site visit and design proposal to material ordering, permit approval, and construction, with timelines that vary according to size, complexity, and municipal review. Elevated and multi-level structures generally require more extensive engineering and inspection than ground-level platforms, and the company factors those requirements into its scheduling for Northglenn projects.

Homeowners in Northglenn can review available deck building services and request assessments that cover material selection, layout, and written cost estimates before construction begins. The company coordinates each stage from initial design through final inspection and schedules work around the region's shorter building season, which typically runs from late spring through early autumn.

The expanded coverage also positions the company to respond more quickly to seasonal repair requests, particularly after winter storms that can damage railings, boards, and support structures. Consistent crews and a defined service area are intended to shorten scheduling times for residents in Northglenn and the

surrounding communities. The company also notes that clear service-area boundaries help set realistic expectations for start dates during the busy summer months, when contractor demand across the Denver suburbs peaks.
